<b>Effective in any Application</b>	✓		WaterCop is an effective solution for single family residences, multifamily residences, and commercial buildings. Flow systems are not effective solutions for applications with varying water needs and usage
<b>Proof of Installation</b>	✓		WaterCop provides an installation verification form to provide your insurer. Flow systems require purchase of an additional service package to receive installation verification.
